Funds the attendance of our students	Allows us to help fund the Montessori education of students in our community via our scholarship program
Funds parent-teacher conferences and direct parent education	Allows us to offer Montessori programming to the Bloomington community at large via workshops with community partners, and participate in community events as a school
Gives us an annual budget for successful operations	Gives us the flexibility to respond to changes (e.g., COVID management) and the security to plan for the future of BMS
