VALUES

Respect-We are a community that strives to treat everyone with respect. This includes active listening, the use of peaceful conflict resolution tools, and an appreciation for diversity of all kinds.

Independence-Allowing your child the room to complete tasks independently, even if this includes some struggle, is a gift to their development. It helps them build self-esteem, a sense of self and purpose, and the determination and tools to master life skills.

Intrinsic Motivation-We avoid the use of short-term extrinsic motivators (such as rewards and punishment) in favor of education toward the long-term development of intrinsic motivation. The ability to find the work of life internally satisfying is a gift to children, worth the investment of time, energy, and patience.

Inclusivity-We recognize the interconnectedness of humans and the Earth. We honor diversity and welcome all into our community.

Holistic Education-We understand that all aspects of a child's development are important. We work toward the development of children who demonstrate all of Bloomington Montessori

School's Learner Outcomes. These include autonomy and independence, confidence and competence, academic preparation, intrinsic motivation, social responsibility, and spiritual awareness. **Read more about the Learner Outcomes in the Parent Handbook. Positive Discipline**-Behavior intervention must include education of the child to aid development of internal self-discipline. A child's self-regulation cannot be dependent on extrinsic motivators.

COMMUNICATION

Respect-Modeling respect is forefront in all communication. This includes active listening, the use of peaceful conflict resolution tools, and an appreciation for diversity of all kinds.

Classroom Communication-Classrooms communicate with parents in a variety of ways. While there are variations among classrooms based on teacher or need, there is a general framework used throughout the school that includes daily, weekly, quarterly, semester, and annual communications. As Concerns Arise-One of the benefits of a smaller school to which parents transport their children daily is the opportunity to discuss important issues with staff as they arise. For quick questions, notifications, or comments, your teacher will usually be available daily at arrival and dismissal times. **Read your classroom's daily schedule.** More complex discussions are best held in meetings scheduled around teacher and parent availability or through email, as arranged with your child's teacher.

Parent Handbook--Critically important information about the school and our policies, procedures, customs and other details is provided in the Parent Handbook, information that is required for parents to navigate successfully their child/ren's time at BMS. **Read the Parent Handbook**.
